TINY LIVES QUILTS

For the second year running Carlbeck patch-workers have made mini quilts and donated them to the Tiny Lives Charity for the Special Baby Unit at Carlisle. Every quilt is unique, being made from scraps of material and to a pattern chosen by each quilter.

The mini quilts are used to cover incubators and are then taken home with the baby. Slightly larger cot quilts have also been made for toddler in-patients and these have proved very popular too.

Last year we cut back from every week to once per month plus a few special extra days and this seemed to work better for our hard working volunteers.
